



2016 Walk, Ride, and Roll to School Mini-Grant recipients

- **Bayside Community Center** will partner with Montgomery Middle School to plan, design, and install a community-developed Linda Vista intersection mural to increase safety, health, and walkability.
- **Cardiff Elementary School** will host safety assemblies and monthly Walk/Bike to School Wednesday events to promote active transportation to school at Cardiff and Ada Harris Elementary.
- **Encinitas Union School District** will host a Walk, Ride, and Roll to School Week to promote active transportation in the community on a district-wide level.
- **Flora Vista Elementary School** will host a Walk to School Week and Bike to School Day to encourage students and parents to leave the car at home and use active transportation.
- **Fuerte Elementary School** will promote, scan, and track student participation in Fuerte Falcons Walk, Ride, Roll, and RUN to Rio!! to increase the number of students who walk, ride, and roll to and from school.
- **Holmes Elementary PTA** will implement a Healthy Hawks Walk and Roll Program, which includes Walk-tober, Walk and Roll Wednesdays, a Bike Festival, and a volunteer crossing guard program.
- **Imperial Beach Charter School** will host two Imperial Beach Charter Bike Rodeos to promote bike safety to and from school at both campuses.
- **Innovation Middle School** students will create posters, videos, window stickers, and t-shirts to create awareness of bike and pedestrian safety, and implement the 25 Mile Club to encourage walking, riding, and rolling to school.
- **Juarez-Lincoln Elementary School** will host bike safety assemblies and a community bike ride to encourage biking to school and create momentum for monthly bike trains.
- **La Costa Heights Elementary School** will host an annual Walk on Wednesday (WOW) campaign, a weeklong celebration leading up to National Walk to School Day, to encourage students and parents to walk or bike to school.

- **Lauderbach Elementary** will host a Walk to School Kick-Off Celebration, followed by National Walk to School Week and weekly Walk to School Wednesday events.
- **Magnolia Elementary School** will create a 10-week Paws on Pedals and Pavement program to encourage active transportation, safety, and care for the environment.
- **Mission Estancia Elementary School** will host a Walk, Ride, and Roll to School Week to encourage active transportation and healthy habits throughout the school year.
- **Solana Beach PTA** will host Walk & Roll Day to remind students about bike and pedestrian safety and encourage increased active transportation at Solana Vista and Skyline Elementary Schools.
- **South Bay Union School District** will host South Bay Knows OUR Way! Walking to School events at Emory and Pence Elementary Schools, including pedestrian and traffic safety education assemblies and a walk to school day.
- **University City High School** will host Step-It-Up, a program centered around the grand opening of a new pedestrian path to encourage stepping out and using active transportation to and from school.
